I believe Kingdom Assignment Sudan is about bringing equality to a group of people who quite simply are the most disadvantaged people in the world.

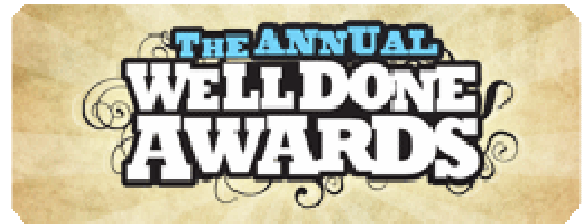
As I have said before, if you see something that is not right, and you have the ability to make it right then you have the **responsibility** to make it right.

Excitement is Building

Plans are moving quickly towards beginning the school building in Tonj.

Kingdom Assignment Sudan is very pleased to be working with **Dr Sean Pickersgill from the School of Architecture and Design at the University of South Australia.**

Sean will be travelling to Kampala (Uganda) Juba, Tonj and Malony in Sudan, to source materials, discuss logistics and assess the site where we will begin the first stage.

There are many challenges to overcome, as this area of Sudan is so remote. We have no communications and all materials need to be brought in from the Ugandan border which is over 8 hours away. All roads to Malony (we believe), may be unpassable during the wet seasons.

Sean will endeavour to investigate this for us on his trip, and then create an accurate building schedule including costings. Below is an idea of how the building(s) might look. This is a great step forward for our project.

They plan to spend this time building relationships with the community, setting up ongoing methods of communication, finding a reliable leader in the community to continue our work while we are absent, and then begin the construction of Stage 1.
