

What's it all about?

The S.O.S. (Saving Of Sudan) Walkathon is a Fundraising Event for Kingdom Assignment Sudan.

Thank you for joining with us in walking the streets of Adelaide and Norwood to help rebuild the Malony-Tonj community in Southern Sudan!

Our Goal: We want to raise \$10 000! To do this we need 100 walkers, each obtaining at least 10 sponsors at \$1 per km. We also want to use this opportunity raise awareness.

The Walk: A 10km route, starting on Bunday Road, North Adelaide, walking through Norwood and back through the city to finish in North Adelaide.

When: Sunday 13th September 2009.

Commencing: 2.00pm – we anticipate it will take approximately 2 hours to complete the walk, slightly longer if you make some stops along the way...

Along The Way: Our route "coincidentally" includes 5 Cibo Café's! A leisurely stroll, coffee in hand, saving a community...what better way to spend a Sunday afternoon!

The T-Shirts: As stated in our goal, we aim to have 100 or more people walking. Imagine the visual impact and the potential for creating awareness for our cause if we all wore the same T-shirt! Therefore, the plan is for every walker to wear our black Kingdom Assignment Sudan T-shirts. The T-shirt purchase price for this event only is \$16.00, however if you raise \$100 or more, the T-shirt will be free. ◆ *What is "Kingdom Assignment Sudan?"*

Kingdom Assignment Sudan is a group of people who have seen the devastation that 21 years of war has left on Southern Sudan, making it the most improvised nation in the world. We want to raise awareness and resources to begin to help rebuild community.

◆ *What are we hoping to achieve?*

We are wanting to raise \$500,000.00 to help rebuild the Malony Community in Tonj, Southern Sudan. This money will build a school, a medical clinic and a church and staff them, so that the people of Malony will have the best future possible.

◆ *What are we doing right now?*

We are busy raising money and finalising the plans so that construction can begin before the end of 2009. We have a team of people going to Malony in December 2009 to build the school and medical clinic, our hope is that both will be operational by the beginning of school, which will start in April 2010.

About Sudan:

Sudan has been the home of much bloodshed since civil war broke out over 50 years ago. The relentless years of war continue to have a devastating impact on it's people striving to survive in one of the most impoverished countries in the world.

Quick Facts:

- 90% of people living in Southern Sudan earn under \$1 a day
- One out of nine women will die during childbirth
- Diseases such as cholera and malaria kill thousands each year
- One in four children under the age of two will die due to malnutrition and preventable diseases
- For those children who do survive, life is tough. Only one in every hundred children will go to school to receive an education, the number even lower for girls and orphans

But... Change is coming!

Faith. Life is a constant struggle, yet the people of Southern Sudan have **FAITH**. A peace agreement has been forged which will allow the people of Southern Sudan to begin the process of independence from Northern Sudan. This means hope to a new nation, a new Sudan.

Hope. Kingdom Assignment Sudan exists to change the future of a generation of people in Tonj, in Southern Sudan. Our **HOPE** is for a sustainable community to be created within ten years. Together we will build a school, a health clinic and a church so that the people of Tonj can have the best future possible.

Love. Participating in this walkathon, either by walking and collecting sponsors, or by sponsoring someone who is walking the 10km, is assisting this generation of people in the Tonj community to have a future. It is **LOVE** in action.

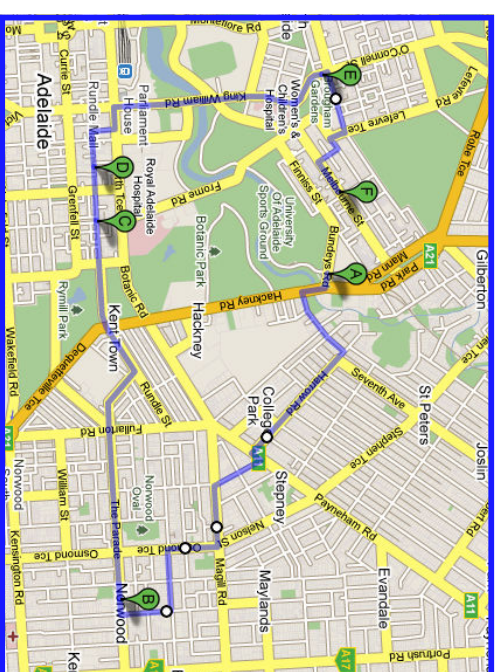
